



Fire Chiefs Report November 8, 2018

I. The Department:

1. Squad 75 is in service. On November 1, 2018, Mosquito Fire District failed to respond to a medical aid call.
2. We have received several calls for deployment of Water Tender 75. Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee District coverage at this time.

II. Personnel:

Volunteer Firefighter Chris Dillinder will oversee Our Rescue Systems capability.
Volunteer Firefighter Johnny Valenzuela will be our Public Information Officer.
Lt. Gregory is now responsible for Fleet Maintenance Manager.
Firefighter Douglas is now our Building and Grounds Manager.

III. Information.

1. **We are currently in Red Flag Weather. All outside fires regardless of purpose is banned by CALFIRE. Please heed this warning.**
2. Crafters will be in the Fire Station December 9, 2018

IV. The Station

1. The Firefighters with help of members from the Support Group, have completed the siding on the west side of the Fire Station. Due to the severity of exterior dry rot, it has been identified that re-siding the whole Fire Station exterior has a greater priority than re-roofing
2. The Air Compressor has been removed and repositioned to the exterior of the Fire Station This has also been done to accommodate the installation of the Exhaust Removal System. The Fire Station will have the siding on the west side replaced. All labor will be provided by District Personnel.
3. The East Wall District logo is completed.
4. Per CALOSHA Regulations the breathing air compressor has been removed from the Apparatus Bay.
