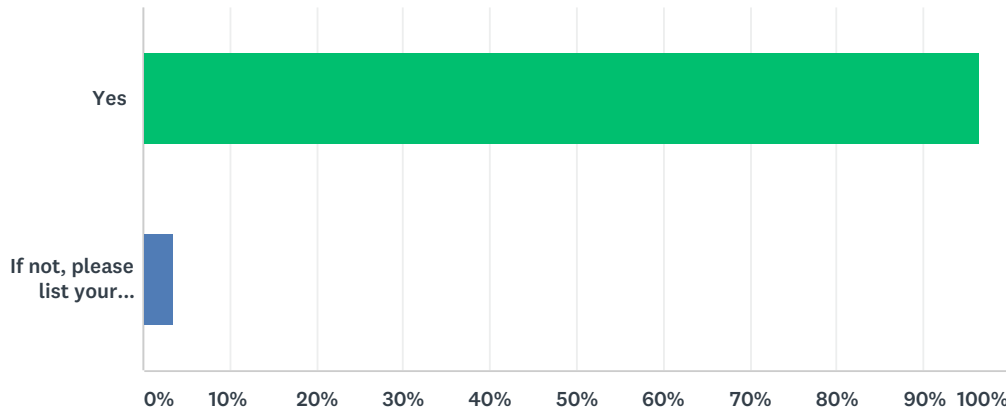

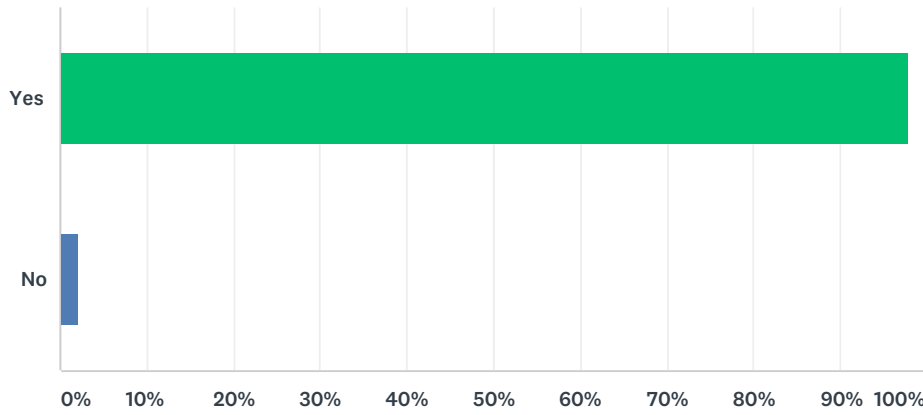

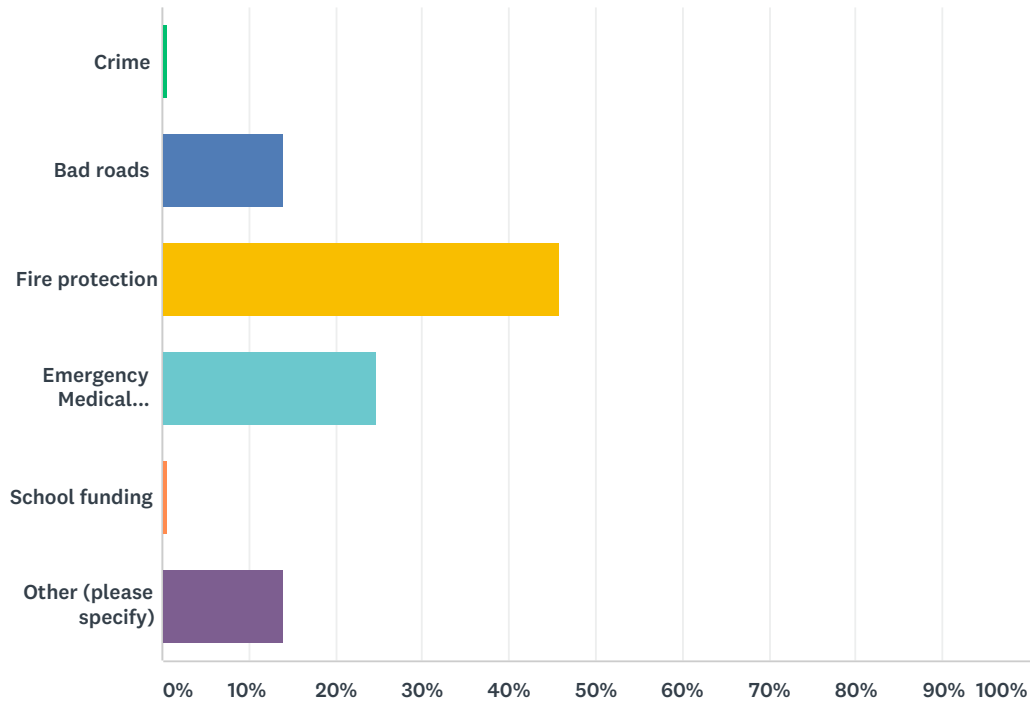

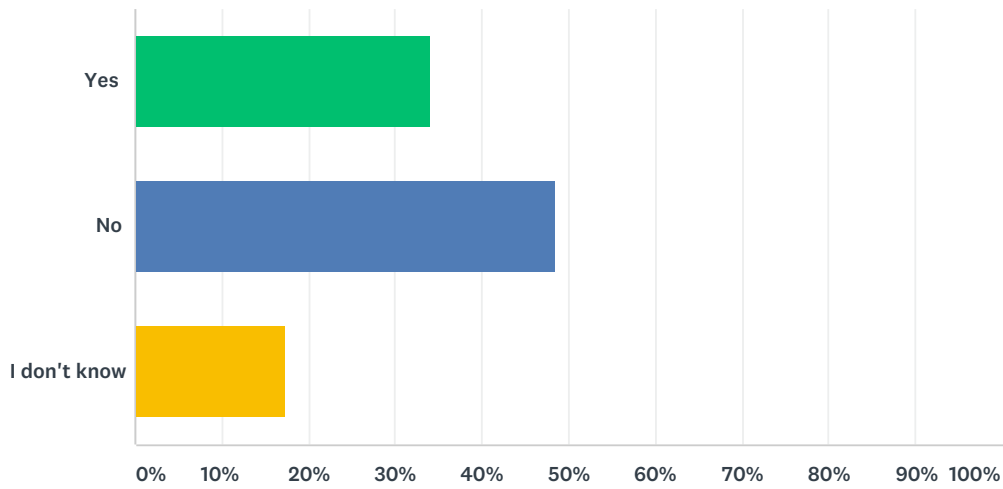

Q6 In general, do you feel that your community is well protected and safe from forest fires and other vegetation/brush type fires?

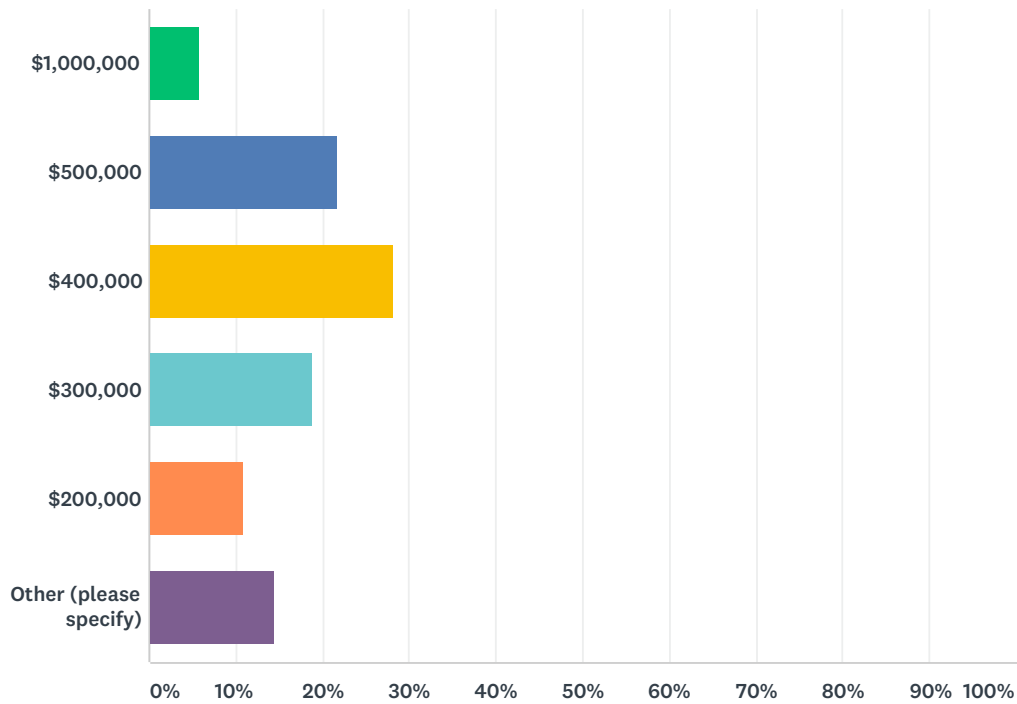

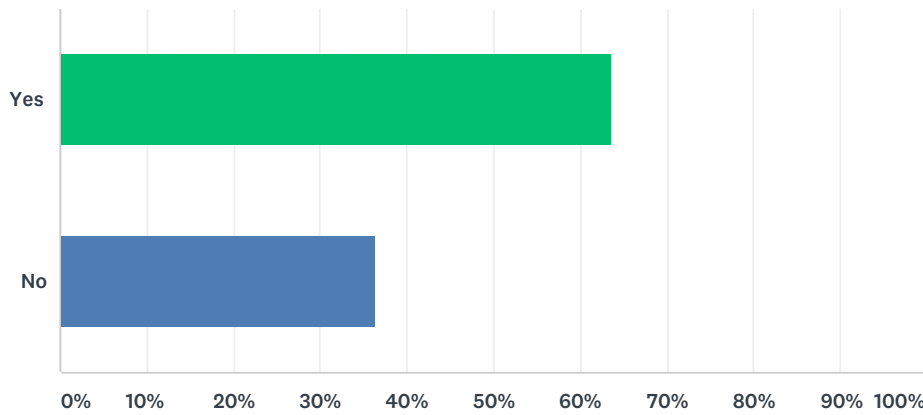

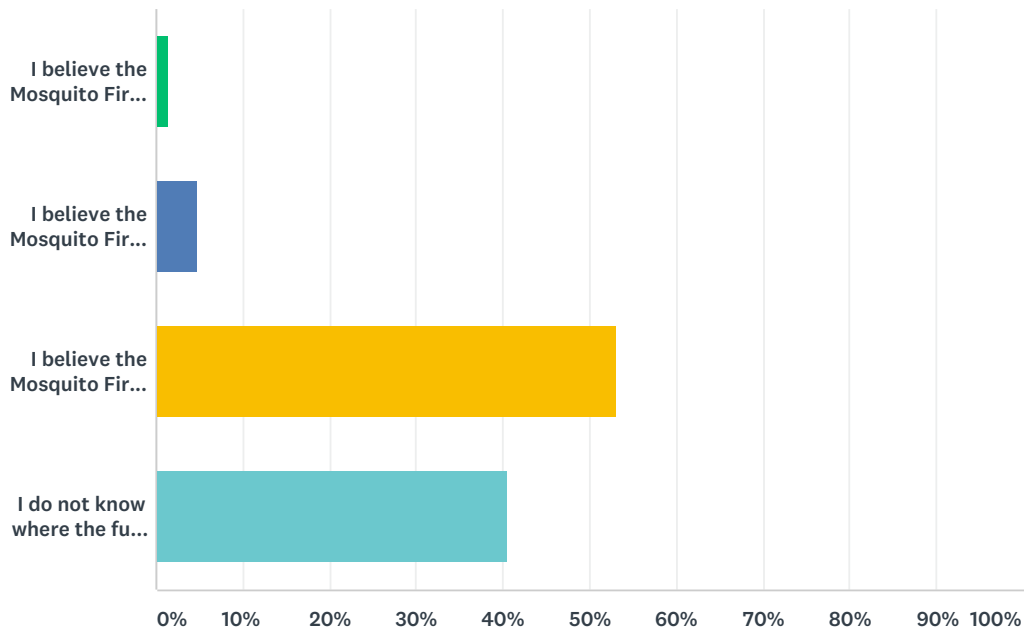

Q9 Is it your understanding that the Mosquito Fire Protection District received a portion of the \$117 CAL FIRE fee?

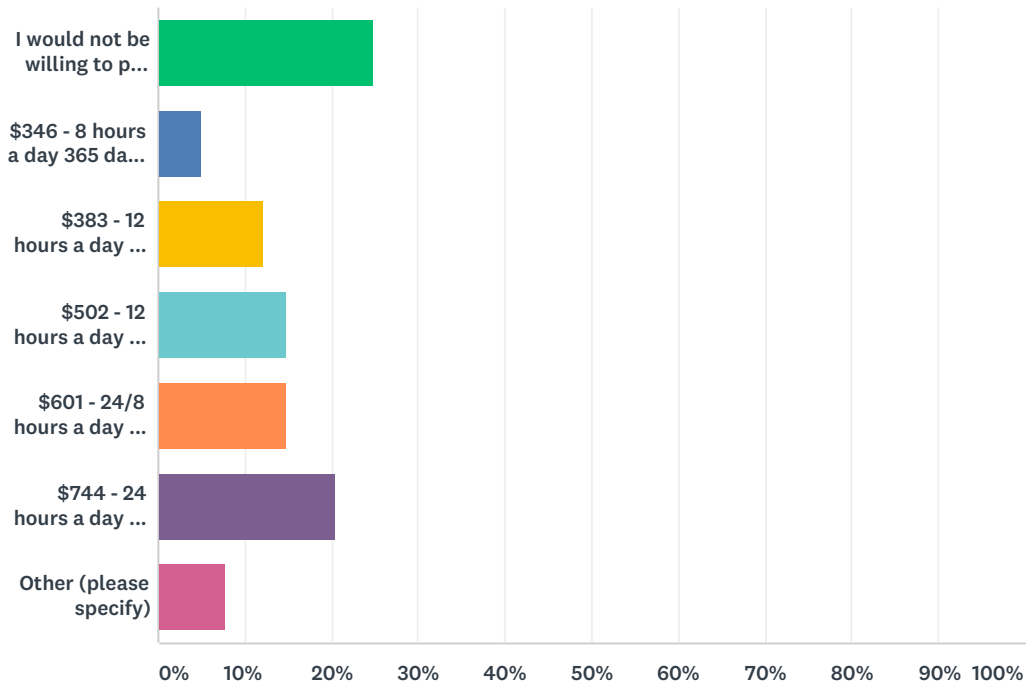

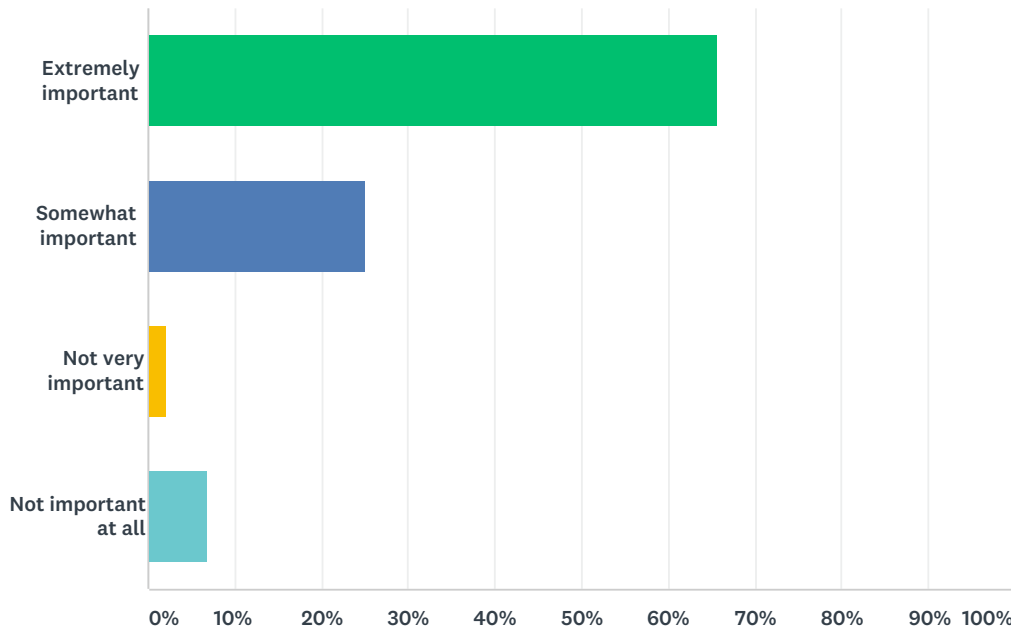

Q11 Do you think that it is extremely important, somewhat important, not very important or not at all important to find additional funding for fire protection, emergency medical and other emergency services in your community?

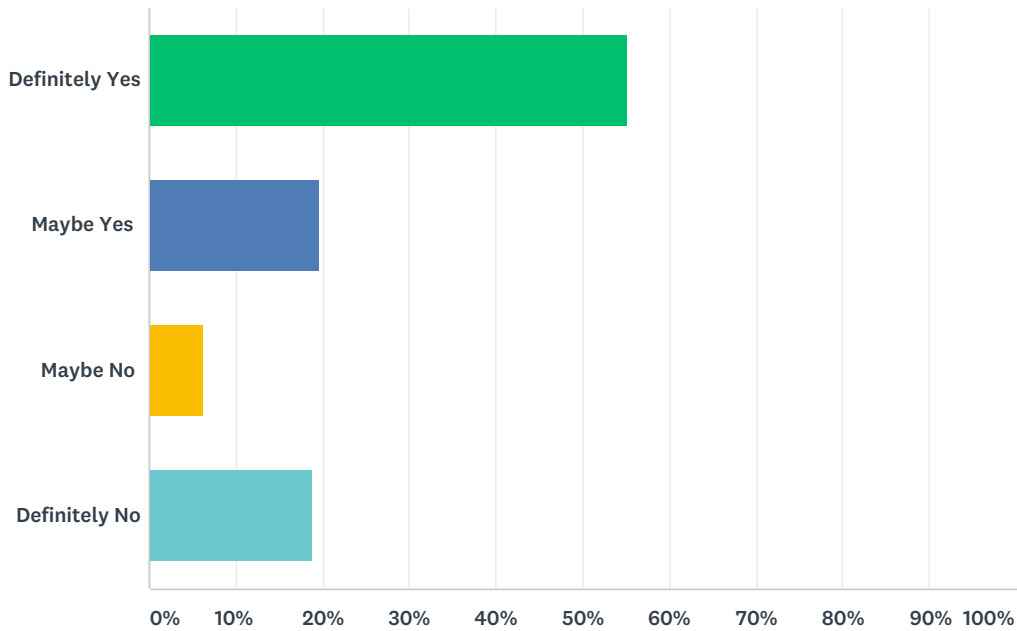

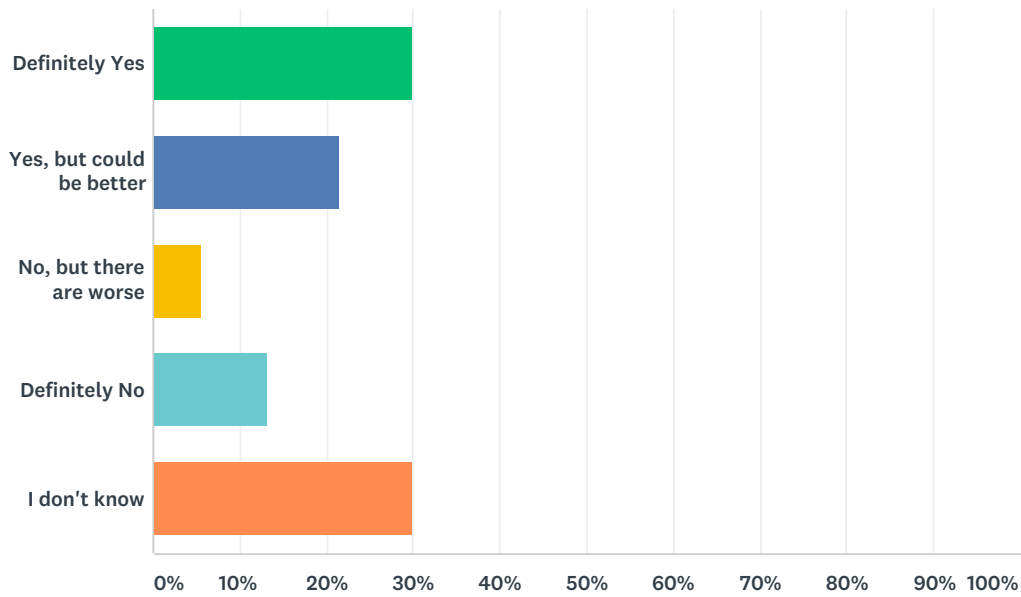

Q13 Do you think the Mosquito Fire Protection District administration is doing a good job managing the budget?

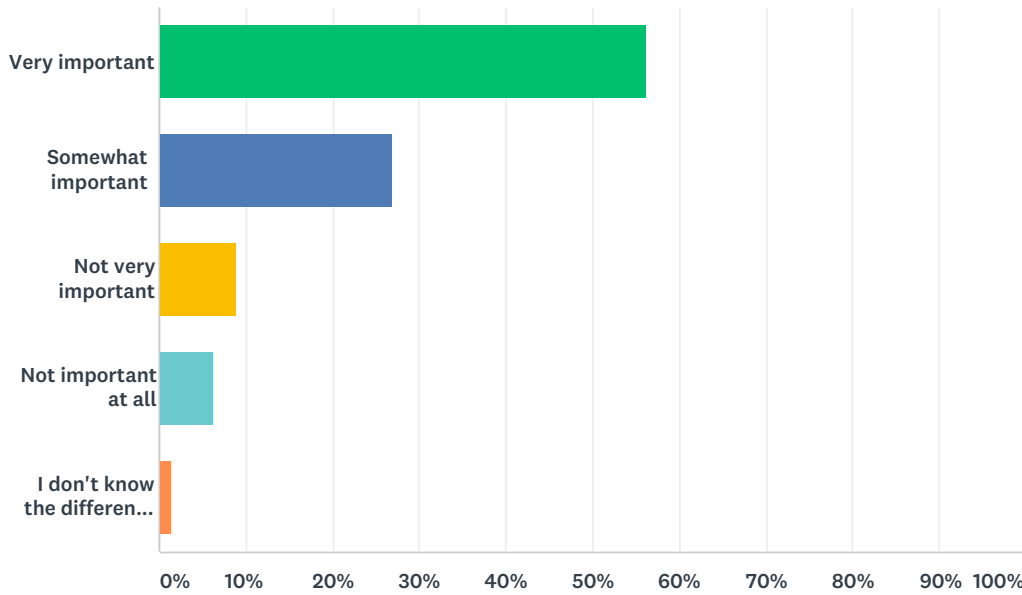

Q14 How important are paramedic services to you?

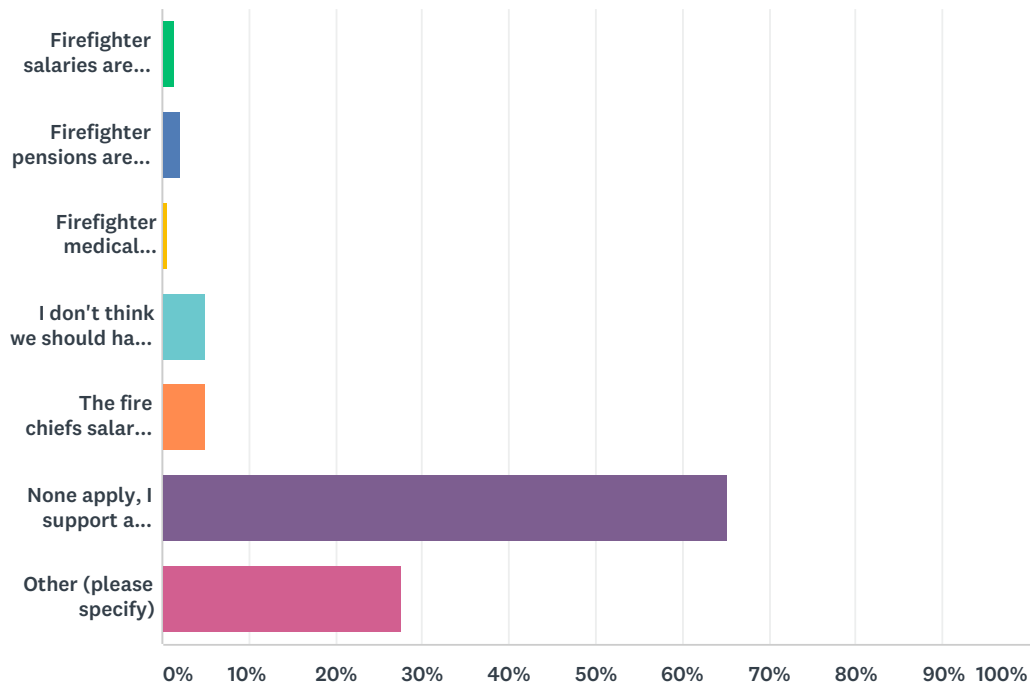

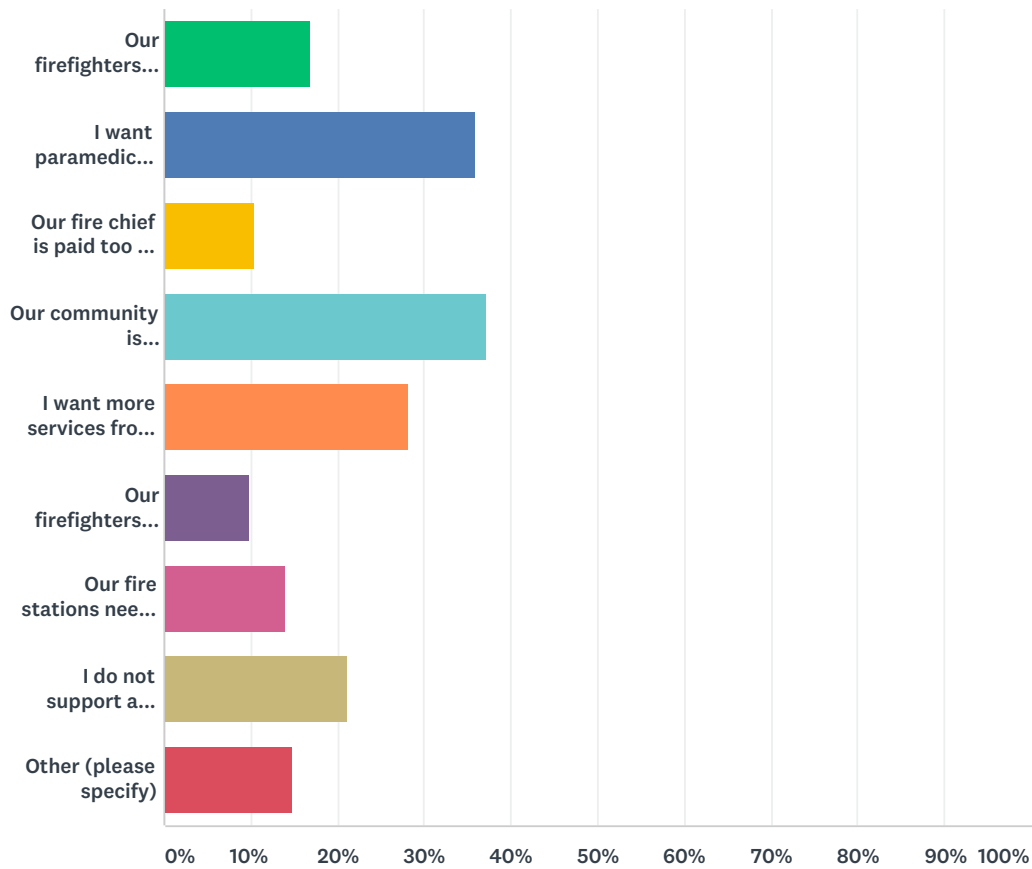

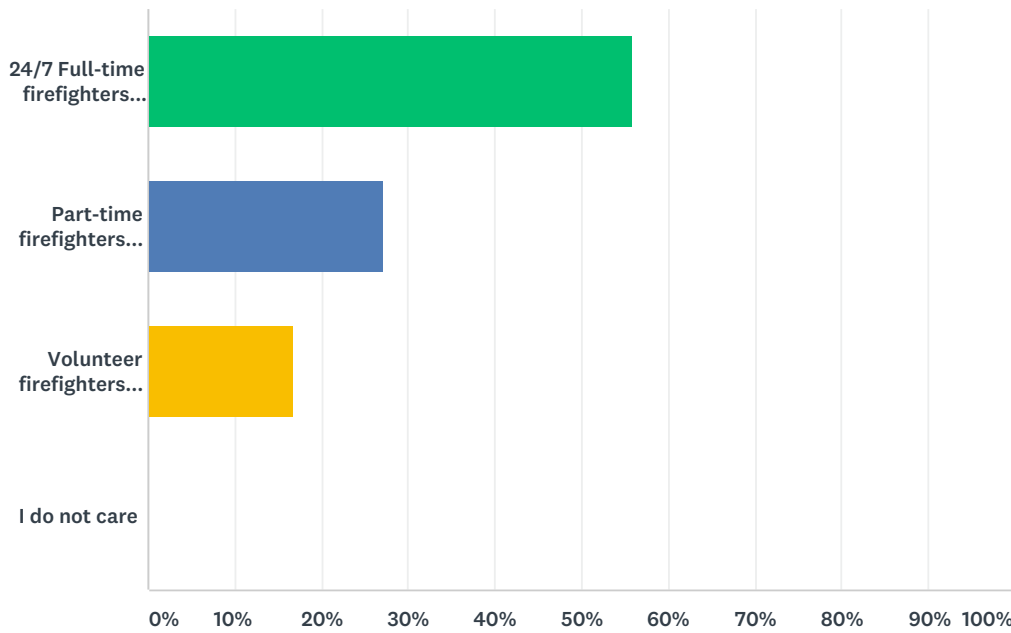
